**The Gift Aid** claim to Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs from the offertories and donations received during January was £2880, which included £793 from the collection at Bishop Kenneth's funeral service. As previously reported, the Government has reduced Gift Aid from 28.2 per cent to 25 percent from April, which, were the change applied to January, would reduce the claim to HMRC to £2552, i.e. a reduction for the month of £328.
